

Mt Huanshan



Mount Hua, is located near the city of Huayin in Shaan'xi province, about 120 kilometres (75 mi) east of Xi'an. It is one of China's Five Great Mountains and has a long history of religious significance. Originally classified as having three peaks, today, it is classified as having five main peaks, of which the highest is the South Peak at 2,154.9 metres (7,070 ft). We will go up to the West Peak of the mountain by cable car and hiking up to the North Peak to enjoy the scenery. Afternoon, we will take the cable car down the mountain. Lunch will not be provided so we suggest that you take a picnic lunch with you.
